### AQUABAY 70 NEW PROJECT

Australian-based Aquabay Yachts, Taiwan shipbuilder TC (Tachou) Yachts, Naval Architect Peter Lowe and Identity Marine Interiors collaborated on the Aquabay 70 project, a yacht that they wanted to be reminiscent of Italian sports yachts—without the price tag—and as versatile as possible. Scheduled to make its world debut at the 2008 Sanctuary Cove Boat Show, the yacht features an awning that extends above the cockpit to create a shaded entertainment area or retracts to allow the sun to flow freely over the sunpads. The hardtop has an opening that brings in natural light to the salon area and accentuates the feeling of space. The adjacent dining area has a table that adjusts to suit guest requirements; it can accommodate up to eight guests for dinner, become a coffee table or transform into a full-size sunbed, according to needs. Walkaround decks and a full-size tender garage enhance the yacht's deck space. Accommodations can include three cabins plus crew quarters or four cabins. The owners' cabin comes standard with a private office area. Built to Bureau Veritas, the yacht is expected to have a 29-knot top speed.

### FORTY ONE DEGREES NORTH NEW(PORT) MARINA

Newport Harbor and Narragansett Bay provide the beautiful setting for a new full-service marina, which had a limited opening early last fall. Encompassing more than 9,000 square feet, the marina resort is designed to accommodate yachts up to 250' with services that include 480-volt electric service, onboard cleaning, VIP launch and ship-side dining. A sweeping open-air bar and restaurant, decorated with an appropriate nautical theme using teak, stainless steel and glass, boasts water vistas from every seat. Four rental suites are available on premises in the heart of Newport, Rhode Island, and a 21-room boutique hotel is scheduled to open in 2009.
